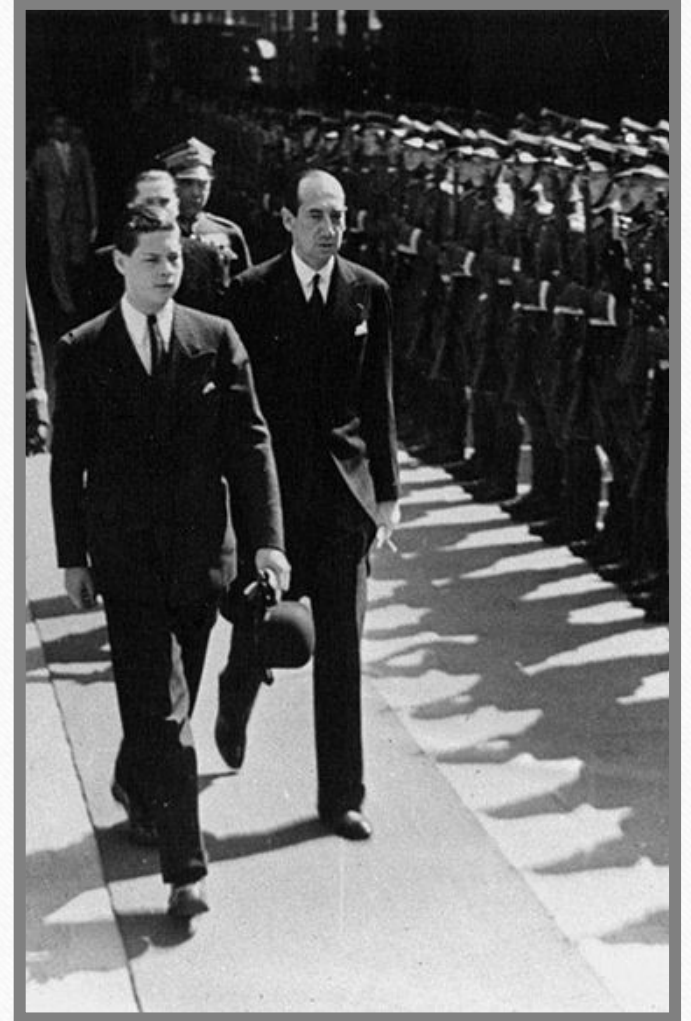


# Polish-Romanian relations before and during WWII
